
As I worked on my Unravel project, it became clear that I needed to edit certain sounds in Pro Tools, particularly the background bird sounds. I experimented with EQ and reverb to create a more refined and immersive auditory backdrop.

The EQ changes were critical in shaping the frequency profile of the bird sounds. This not only improved the clarity of the birdsong but also helped to eliminate unwanted elements such as wind noise and mic pops. The subtle changes allowed the bird sounds to emerge more clearly, seamlessly blending into the scenes without distracting things.



Simultaneously, adjusting the reverb settings was critical in achieving a natural and cohesive sonic environment. I was able to seamlessly integrate the bird sounds into the overall ambiance of the Unravel clips by tailoring the reverberation characteristics.

These edits weren't just technical manoeuvres in the intimate space of Pro Tools; they were artistic decisions. They gave me the freedom to create a unique auditory experience, ensuring that the background bird sounds not only complemented the visuals but also evoked a sense of immersion, free of distracting noises and imbued with a distinct, polished quality.
